The Austrian Rowing Federation (ÖRV) is looking for
3 FULL-TIME YOUTH COACHES
on a full-time employment basis

One position is to be filled in each of our three performance centres: Upper Austria (Ottensheim), Vienna and Carinthia (Völkermarkt).

The ÖRV youth coaches' primary purpose is to support the growth and development of rowing in Austria by supporting the delivery of athlete development and nurturing club and coach development initiatives. Our aim is to inspire and nurture the coming generations of high-performance athletes.

ÖRV youth coaches are expected to plan, organize and undertake operations that introduce, support and train young people, in accordance with uniform ÖRV training principles, for top-level sport.

In addition, this position requires the provision of support to club coaches, at performance centres or in clubs, both in practice (training sessions in the clubs/performance centres) and through training modules for athletes and/or workshops for club coaches ("Coach the Coaches").

We are searching for highly motivated and energetic individuals with strong communication skills, and the ability to forge quality working relationships with key stakeholders in our rowing community.

TASKS:

- TEAMWORK – Collaborate with the wider coaching group to align club and national development objectives, including other national coaches and the ÖRV talent scout
- Support club coaches in the planning and implementation of training sessions in close cooperation and consultation with the ÖRV head junior coach
- Organize and manage logistics associated with day-to-day training, regattas and training camps
- Organize and conduct coaching sessions for coaches and athletes
- Maintain and manage ÖRV boat fleet, including rigging and repair work
- Acceptance of the ÖRV code of honor and compliance with the WADA code

REQUIREMENTS:

- High level of self-motivation and enjoyment in working with Junior A & B rowers
- University degree in the field of sports (diploma, bachelor, master) and/or BSPA coaching diploma (or internationally comparable rowing coaches license)
- Structured, independent work
- Track record of excellence in coaching sculling and sweep rowing
- Experience working with minors in a sporting environment
- Knowledge and experience in training planning, training execution and procurement and adjustment of boat equipment
